The above resolution, approved May 6 at the Regional Convention in Asbury Park, New Jersey, was made after specific note was taken of unwarranted discrimination against news photographers at the recent Hiss talk at Princeton University and of illegal interference at Washington and Lee University upon Senator Barkley's collapse during a speech there.
