

Copy of Resolution passed at a meeting of the Lexington
school Board held July 12, 1934

In response to the petition of the colored citizens asking for an additional year of high school work at the colored school, the Board reviewed the report made by Supt. Irby some weeks ago, in which he estimated the total attendance in the colored high school for next session to be fifty with the prospects of nine students for the third year's work. After a full and lengthy discussion of this whole question, the Board passed the following order:

Resolved that for the school year 1934-35 with reference to the colored high school for Lexington, Va. :

1. All resident high school pupils shall pay ~~shall~~ pay tuition at the rate of twelve dollars (\$12.00) per session, and pupils not living in the corporate limits of the Town of Lexington shall pay twenty-seven dollars (\$27.00) per session. One-half of the tuition shall be paid at the beginning of the session and the remainder on or before February 1st.

2. That one additional accredited teacher shall be added to the high school staff.

3. That there shall be added for one school year a third year of high school work to the present curriculum.

4. That the continuance of the third year of high school and this additional teacher shall depend upon a material increase in the number of high school pupils and the united support of the colored citizens of Lexington.

5. The necessary equipment is ordered to be bought.

Copy of Resolution passed at a meeting of the Lexington

School Board held July 12, 1934

In response to the petition of the colored citizens asking for an additional year of high school work at the colored school, the Board reviewed the report made by the colored citizens at the meeting held at the school on the 11th inst. in the colored high school for the next session to be held with the prospects of nine students for the third year's work. After a full and lengthy discussion of this whole question, the Board passed the following order:

Resolved that for the school year 1934-35 with reference to the colored high school for Lexington, Va.:

1. The regular high school tuition shall be \$12.00 per year for the rate of twelve dollars (\$12.00) per session, and pupils not living in the corporate limits of the town of Lexington shall pay twenty-dollar tuition (\$20.00) per session. One-half of the tuition shall be paid at the beginning of the session and the remainder on or before February 1st.

2. That one additional accredited teacher shall be added to the high school staff.

3. That there shall be added for one school year a third year of high school work to the present curriculum.

4. That the continuance of the third year of high school and this additional teacher shall depend upon a material increase in the number of high school pupils and the united support of the colored citizens of Lexington.

5. The necessary equipment is ordered to be bought.
