

Fort Delaware

June 1st 1864

Dear Sister-

I have at last some prospect of getting a letter through the lines. I was captured near Spotsylvania on the 12th May & arrived at this place on the 17th -

I am very comfortably situated, have an abundance of bedding & will get clothing this week.

I have heard from Sallie & Uncle Tom both of whom have kindly offered me assistance. Sallie is not very well but Nell is in excellent health. Uncle Tom's Aunt & 3 children are well and still living at Paris Ky. If it is possible I wish you to write you may get at letter through by directing Per Flag Ence, Fort Del Officers barracks Division 22 Care of Capt Abel A A G.

We have religious exercises here regularly & there is a great interest manifested about 20 have professed faith in the last 15 days.

St Lyle is well, I don't know anything about the rest of the Co as we were separated from them. May God bless you all & grant that we may meet again if not on this earth in heaven
