text:

Dear Sidney,

I'm so sorry about the telegrams--and so sorry,
too, not to have had the chance to be with you. But
Tennessee and I decided not to make the trip.

So I intend to be here all winter. I do wish
you could come up here. What are the chances of your
visiting me?

I don't get any better--and I hate living like
this.

I think of you so often. Do try to come up when
you have a few days free.
