We had two sons killed Bro's
Tom Gorrell & Kenner & we
wounded -

My dear Sister does differently
I feel more exposed to death &
danger with God as a pro-
tector, I am not what may
be the Initiatives & dangers
knowing that God can bring
me safely through them all.

I will have to close my
letter as we have to go
on inspection, my best love
to my little Niece, we done
this it for me

Dear Sister

I have at last received
letters from home, one of the
10th, one of the 27th of June, I was
truly glad to get them as they are
the first for a month the longest
time I have been without letters.

Since I last wrote we have
passed through trying scenes -
through all of which by the
mercy of God I have been
spared whilst others have been
cut down. In the third of
the series of battles around Gettys-
burg our little band of boys
were all killed wounded &
taken prisoners except Flint
Jones, Whiteman & myself, well
& feel thankful that I am spared.

Our Regt has only 66 men left & the whole division suffered proportionately, through the folly of our dead fighting Johnson.

He has none of the qualities of a Gen but expects to do every thing by fighting, three or four times did he throw out gallant assault against powerful breast works & Yankees without number each time mowing them down.

I cannot give you a list of the killed & wounded as they were left in the hands of the enemy except Horace Paxton & Frank Arnold. I escaped by being in the rear of the regiment to prevent men from going off their field unnecessarily, I had a very disagreeable position as I was exposed to the fire of

the enemy & could not find myself a position I do not at all care -

If you I will not venture an opinion on the battle as you can judge from our papers, what the result of it was, we were not whipped, though we suffered heavily. The first two days fighting was entirely in our favor now unfortunate we attempted to drive them from an impregnable position -

We are now lying near Hazen's Farm Rd, whether Lee intended going across the river or not I cannot tell, but if we do have to fight again we will have fair field & I fear not the result -
